



DIRECTED SELF-PLACEMENT FOR COLLEGE WRITING

After completing your directed self-placement survey, you can register for either **ENG 1010** or **ENG 1020**.

ENG 1010:

Basic Writing is a three-credit, pass/fail course focused on reading and writing skills and composing broad genres of academic writing such as summaries, analyses, and reflections. While ENG 1010 does not fulfill a General Education requirement, it provides excellent preparation for a course that does fulfill a General Education requirement in writing, ENG 1020

ENG 1020:

Introduction to College Writing is a three-credit course that teaches students to integrate reading, research, and writing in the academic genres of analysis and argument. In this class, students use and analyze rhetoric (or persuasion) and learn how to understand audiences and rhetorical situations within different types of writing. ENG 1020 fulfills the “Basic Composition” General Education requirement.
