#### **Submission General Instructions:**

- 1. Abstract submission opens at 8 am EST on January 8th, 2024. All abstracts must be received by 8am EST on March 11th, 2024.
- 2. Medical students, residents, and teaching faculty are all eligible to make submissions.
- 3. Submissions must include a completed submission application as well as an abstract (to be included in symposium program).
- 4. Resident/medical student submission must include 1 presenter, who is required to be physically present dressed in business casual at the symposium, and 1 preceptor/attending, who is not required to be physically present.
- 5. You will receive an email acknowledging receipt of your submission when it is received.
- 6. Once accepted, presenter will be responsible to turn in final project electronically by May 1<sup>nd</sup>, 2024 and be physically present at the symposium at ProMedica Monroe Regional Hospital 8 am 4 pm on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024.
- 7. It is permitted to submit materials that may be presented at another conference. It is important to review the instructions for submission at another conference which may not make this allowance.

## **Submission Categories:**

- 1. Poster Presentation
  - a. Purpose: Present a (**36x48 in**) poster of completed or work-in-progress topic of choice (examples include but are not limited to case reports, continuous quality improvement (CQI) projects, pre-/post-intervention projects, patient safety initiatives, provider wellness initiatives, etc.).
  - b. Time: 30 minute staffing poster during dedicated poster time; poster will remain on display for the entirety of symposium
- 2. Oral Power Point Presentation
  - a. Purpose: Present completed or work-in-progress topic of choice (examples include but are not limited to case reports, continuous quality improvement (CQI) projects, pre-/post-intervention projects, patient safety initiatives, provider wellness initiatives, etc.).
  - b. Time: 10 minutes of PowerPoint presentation with 5 minutes for questions/discussion
- 3. Lecture Session Presentation
  - a. Purpose: Present a completed or work-in-progress topic of choice (examples include but are not limited to continuous quality improvement (CQI) projects, pre-/post-intervention projects, patient safety initiatives, provider wellness initiatives, etc.).
  - b. Time: 20 minutes of PowerPoint presentation with 5 minutes for questions/discussion.

### Awards will be given in the following categories:

- \*First, Second, and Third for Poster Presentation
- \*First, Second, and Third for Oral Power Point Presentation
- \*First, Second, and Third for Quality Improvement project (either oral power point or poster)
